AN ACT CONCERNING PAROLE AND PROBATION TRANSPARENCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2009*) The Department of
2 Correction shall notify the police chief and chief elected official of a
3 municipality every thirty days of the names and addresses of the
4 persons, if any, released from confinement in a correctional facility into
5 that municipality on probation or parole or pursuant to any other
6 community release program within the previous thirty days and the
7 support and assistance that is being provided to such persons to
8 facilitate their reentry into the community.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To give law enforcement and local communities more tools to track ex-offenders who might reoffend and to help community-based organizations identify ex-offenders and assist their reentry into the community.
