**AN ACT CONCERNING AN INCOME TAX CREDIT FOR NEW  
EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS AND PARAMEDICS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 229 of the general statutes be amended to allow new
- 2 emergency medical technicians and paramedics to take a credit against
- 3 their personal income tax in an amount equal to the cost of training to
- 4 become an emergency medical technician or paramedic.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To allow new EMTs and paramedics to take a credit on their income tax in an amount equal to the cost of their training.
