AN ACT BANNING THE PURCHASE, OWNERSHIP AND USE OF ALL STUN WEAPONS BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit the purchase,
- 2 ownership and use of electronic defense weapons by law enforcement
- 3 agencies in this state, and that "electronic defense weapon" shall be
- 4 defined as a weapon which by electronic impulse or current is capable
- 5 of immobilizing a person temporarily, including a stun gun or other
- 6 conductive energy device.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit the possession and use of electronic defense weapons such as stun guns and conductive energy devices by law enforcement agencies in this state.
