AN ACT GIVING MUNICIPALITIES THE OPTION OF USING "RED LIGHT" CAMERA SYSTEMS FOR TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to authorize the use of red
- 2 light camera systems to provide twenty-four-hour automated
- 3 enforcement; that municipalities be given the option to install digital
- 4 video imaging technology to enable the use of a noninvasive, video-
- 5 based traffic monitoring system for automated enforcement of red
- 6 light violations; and that municipalities be authorized to retain a
- 7 portion of the funds received from the use of such monitoring system.

Statement of Purpose:

To authorize use of traffic cameras and allow municipalities to retain a portion of fines.
