**AN ACT CONCERNING THE REGISTRATION PERIOD FOR SENIOR
CITIZENS AT INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 185 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Board of Trustees of the Community-Technical Colleges, the Board of
- 3 Trustees of the Connecticut State University System, and the Board of
- 4 Trustees of The University of Connecticut to increase the period
- 5 during which Connecticut residents sixty-two years of age or older,
- 6 who have been accepted for admission to the institution and who
- 7 qualify for a tuition waiver, can register for courses.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase access to higher education at state colleges and universities
for senior citizens.
