**AN ACT CONCERNING RECIPROCAL AND CONCURRENT  
SANCTIONS FOR OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE OR A VESSEL  
WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR OR ANY  
DRUG.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that reciprocal and  
2 concurrent sanctions be established for violations of the laws  
3 prohibiting the operation of a motor vehicle while under the influence  
4 and the operation of a vessel while under the influence; that, if a  
5 person's motor vehicle operator's license is suspended, such person's  
6 safe boating certificate shall also be suspended; and that for purposes  
7 of determining whether a violation is a second or subsequent violation  
8 for suspension purposes, a prior violation of either the law prohibiting  
9 the operation of a motor vehicle while intoxicated or the law  
10 prohibiting the operation of a vessel while intoxicated, or any  
11 combination thereof, shall constitute a prior violation or violations.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide reciprocal and concurrent penalties for driving and boating under the influence.
