AN ACT PROVIDING ASSAULT VICTIMS ACCESS TO GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEM MONITORING DEVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to extend global positioning
- 2 system monitoring to assault victims or potential assault victims for
- 3 their protection so that they can be alerted if a person who has been
- 4 convicted of assaulting them in the past is in close proximity.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect assault victims and potential assault victims from future assaults, especially in domestic violence situations, by allowing such victims to have access to a type of GPS monitoring device similar to what an offender wears that would enable them to know if their attacker was nearby.
