AN ACT PROVIDING A VALID FORM OF IDENTIFICATION TO PERSONS RELEASED FROM STATE CUSTODY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that a state identity
- 2 card be issued to every resident of this state who is released from the
- 3 custody of the state if such person does not already possess such an
- 4 identity card.

Statement of Purpose:

To address a barrier that exists for the ex-offender population in reentering the community and securing employment.
