**AN ACT REQUIRING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A REASONABLE
"CAP" ON REPAIR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE FAILURE OF
THE EMISSIONS INSPECTION OF MOTOR VEHICLES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to modify the current
- 2 emissions testing process by establishing a reasonable "cap" on repair
- 3 costs associated with the failure of a motor vehicle to pass an emissions
- 4 test.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect the consumer from unreasonable costly repairs that exceed the actual assessed or book value of the car being tested and are associated with car computer problems.
