AN ACT REQUIRING MOTOR VEHICLES TO COME TO A COMPLETE STOP AT A TRAFFIC SIGNAL THAT IS NOT ILLUMINATED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require motor vehicles to
- 2 come to a complete stop at a traffic signal that is not illuminated due to
- 3 a power failure or other similar malfunction.

Statement of Purpose:

To require motorists to stop when approaching a "dark" signalized intersection.
