AN ACT CONCERNING NOLLED CRIMINAL CHARGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 961a of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that if any criminal charge against a person has been nolleed, that
- 3 criminal charge shall not be entered in such person's criminal history
- 4 record and shall not appear in any police or court records or the
- 5 records of the prosecuting attorney.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that a criminal charge that is nolleed does not appear in a person's criminal history record and in the records of the police, court and prosecutor.
