AN ACT CONCERNING INTERNET LURING OF A CHILD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish the crime of
- 2 Internet luring of a child which is committed when a person more than
- 3 four years older than a child under fifteen years of age knowingly
- 4 communicates a statement over a computer or computer network to
- 5 such child, describing sexual conduct and in connection with the
- 6 communication, makes a statement persuading or inviting the child to
- 7 meet the person for any purpose, and to provide that schools shall be
- 8 encouraged to educate children in grade three or above regarding
- 9 Internet safety.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect children from Internet predators by establishing the crime of Internet luring.
