AN ACT CONCERNING INTERNET SEXUAL EXPLOITATION OF A CHILD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to establish the crime of
2 Internet sexual exploitation of a child which is committed when a
3 person who is at least four years older than a child who is under fifteen
4 years of age knowingly requests or encourages the child through
5 communication via a computer network or system to (1) expose or
6 touch the child's own or another person's intimate parts while
7 communicating with the person via a computer network or system, or
8 (2) observe the person's intimate parts while communicating with the
9 person via a computer network or system, and that the crime of
10 Internet sexual exploitation shall be a class C felony.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish the crime of Internet sexual exploitation of a child.
