AN ACT CONCERNING THE TIME LIMIT FOR ENFORCING A STATE COURT JUDGMENT IN A FOREIGN JURISDICTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allow a postjudgment
- 2 motion in state court to reaffirm a judgment within twenty years of the
- 3 award in order to allow collection of the award in a foreign
- 4 jurisdiction.

Statement of Purpose:

To amend postjudgment procedures to allow a state judgment award to be revived in a manner that permits enforcement of the award in a foreign jurisdiction within the twenty-year-limitation period provided in this state.
