AN ACT CONCERNING THE REMOVAL OF REGISTERED SEXUAL OFFENDERS FROM SOCIAL NETWORKING SITES ON THE INTERNET.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 969 of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 registered sex offenders to provide the Department of Public Safety
- 3 with Internet accounts and screen names used for social networking
- 4 purposes and authorize social networking web sites to access sex
- 5 offender registry information, prescreen or remove sex offenders from
- 6 their sites and notify law enforcement officials if there is a potential
- 7 violation of law or threat to public safety.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect children from Internet predators.
