**AN ACT CONCERNING FINGERPRINT COLLECTION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2009*) No municipal police  
2 station or state police station shall refuse to collect the fingerprints of a  
3 person requesting such fingerprinting for the purposes of a criminal  
4 history records check in accordance with section 29-17a of the general  
5 statutes or other noncriminal purpose based upon such person's  
6 residence in another municipality.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>October 1, 2009</i>	New section

**Statement of Purpose:**

To prohibit police departments from refusing to fingerprint a person based upon such person's residence.
