AN ACT CONCERNING FINGERPRINT COLLECTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2009*) (a) No employee of a
2 municipal police department or the Division of State Police within the
3 Department of Public Safety shall refuse to collect the fingerprints of a
4 person requesting such fingerprinting for the purposes of a criminal
5 history records check in accordance with section 29-17a of the general
6 statutes, or other noncriminal purposes, provided (1) such employee's
7 duties include fingerprint collection, and (2) the person requesting
8 such fingerprinting works or resides in the municipality where such
9 department or division is located.

10 (b) The provisions of this section shall not be construed to prohibit a
11 municipality from establishing a limited period of hours during which
12 such fingerprints may be collected.

13 (c) A municipality may charge a reasonable fee for collecting
14 fingerprints under this section.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
