**AN ACT CONCERNING DISCLOSURE BY RESTAURANTS OF
KNOWN FOOD ALLERGENS IN SERVED FOODS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Commissioner
- 2 of Public Health to adopt regulations that would require restaurants to
- 3 disclose to their consumers the presence of known food allergens in
- 4 the food served by such restaurants.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect consumers from unknowingly consuming food containing ingredients to which they may be allergic.
