AN ACT CONCERNING MILITARY FAMILIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 27-100a of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
3 *passage*):

4 (a) As used in this section, (1) "department" means the Military
5 Department, (2) "fund" means the Military Family Relief Fund
6 established in accordance with this section, (3) "eligible member of the
7 armed forces" and "eligible member" means a member of the armed
8 forces, as defined in subsection (a) of section 27-103, including the
9 Connecticut National Guard, [who is on active duty and] who is
10 domiciled in this state, (4) "immediate family member" means an
11 eligible member's spouse, child or parent who is domiciled in this
12 state, or any other member of an eligible member's family who lives in
13 the same household as the eligible member, and (5) "essential personal
14 or household goods or services" includes, but is not limited to, repairs,
15 medical services that are not covered by insurance, transportation,
16 babysitting, clothing, school supplies or any other goods or services

17 that are essential to the well-being of an eligible member's immediate
18 family.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	27-100a(a)

To expand eligibility for assistance to military families under the Military Family Relief Fund.
