**AN ACT CONCERNING THE CERTIFICATION OF A CHIEF OF POLICE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of  
2 sections 7-294d and 7-294e of the general statutes, the Police Officer  
3 Standards and Training Council shall not consider the certification of a  
4 local chief of police who has retired as an active chief of police in the  
5 state and who has returned to the state as an interim chief of police less  
6 than three years after his or her retirement lapsed, and shall grant an  
7 extension of such certification for the duration of such interim term  
8 without requiring additional training pursuant to section 7-294d of the  
9 general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
