AN ACT AMENDING REGULATIONS FOR PORTABLE ELECTRIC SPAS AND CERTAIN OTHER PRODUCTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subparagraph (N) of subdivision (1) of subsection (d) of
2 section 16a-48 of the general statutes is repealed and the following is
3 substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

4 (N) On or after January 1, 2009, bottle-type water dispensers,
5 commercial hot food holding cabinets, portable electric spas, walk-in
6 refrigerators and walk-in freezers shall meet the efficiency
7 requirements of section 1605.3 of the January 2006 California Code of
8 Regulations, Title 20, Division 2, Chapter 4, Article 4: Appliance
9 Efficiency Regulations, as may be amended from time to time. On or
10 after January 1, 2010, residential pool pumps shall meet said efficiency
11 requirements.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
