**AN ACT CONCERNING SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING
AND MATHEMATICS ISSUES IN CONNECTICUT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2009*). The State Board of
2 Education may authorize the Connecticut Academy for Education in
3 Mathematics, Science and Technology to serve as an impartial
4 convening agent for organizations, teachers, administrators, school
5 officials, policymakers, parents and students to foster, promote, study,
6 report and make recommendations to the board on education issues
7 relating to science, technology, engineering and mathematics in
8 Connecticut.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
