**AN ACT CONCERNING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR
REHABILITATION OF HOMES IN THE NEWHALL NEIGHBORHOOD
OF THE TOWN OF HAMDEN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (34) of subsection (f) of section 13 of public
2 act 07-6 of the June special session is repealed and the following is
3 substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

4 (34) Purchase, rehabilitation or demolition of severely structurally
5 damaged homes caused by historic fill within the Newhall
6 neighborhood in Hamden, or for a grant-in-aid to the [town of]
7 Hamden Economic Development Corporation to fund the reasonable
8 costs related to the purchase, rehabilitation or demolition of the
9 severely structurally damaged homes caused by historic fill within the
10 Newhall neighborhood, not exceeding \$2,000,000.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To transfer from the town of Hamden to the Hamden Economic Development Corporation a grant-in-aid to be used for the rehabilitation and demolition of homes with severe structural damage in the Newhall neighborhood.
