AN ACT CONCERNING FALSE STATEMENTS TO CERTAIN LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 53a-157a of the general statutes is repealed and
2 the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2009*):

3 (a) A person is guilty of false statement in the first degree when he;
4 [intentionally] (1) Intentionally makes a false written statement on a
5 certified payroll submitted pursuant to section 31-53 which he does not
6 believe to be true and which statement is intended to mislead a
7 contracting authority or the labor commissioner in the exercise of his
8 authority or the fulfillment of his duties under chapter 557; or (2)
9 intentionally makes a false statement to any chief inspector, inspector
10 appointed pursuant to subsection (a) of section 51-286 or special
11 inspector appointed pursuant to subsection (a) of section 51-285 which
12 such person does not believe to be true and that is intended to mislead
13 the law enforcement officer in the performance of his duties.

14 (b) False statement in the first degree is a class D felony.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To designate the making of a false statement to certain inspectors appointed by the Chief State's Attorney a class D felony crime.
