**AN ACT PROHIBITING THE ACQUISITION OR USE OF CERTAIN
PARCELS OF LAND AS ASH RESIDUE DISPOSAL AREAS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit the Connecticut
2 Resources Recovery Authority from condemning, purchasing, leasing,
3 accepting or taking title to, using, or otherwise acquiring any portion
4 of a certain parcel of land located in the town of Franklin for the
5 purpose of establishing an ash residue disposal area. That the general
6 statutes be amended to prohibit the Connecticut Resources Recovery
7 Authority from condemning, purchasing, leasing, accepting or taking
8 title to, using, or otherwise acquiring any portion of a certain parcel of
9 land located in the town of Windham for the purpose of establishing
10 an ash residue disposal area.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit the Connecticut Resources Recovery Authority from acquiring or using any portion of two parcels of land located in Windham and Franklin, respectively.
