AN ACT CONCERNING TRANSPARENCY OF MEDICAL LOSS RATIO INFORMATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to require insurers,
- 2 health care centers, hospital or medical service corporations or other
- 3 organizations delivering, issuing for delivery, renewing or amending
- 4 any individual or group health insurance policy in this state to include
- 5 a provision in the contract at the time of sale or issuance that states the
- 6 medical loss ratio of such company or organization.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish transparency for consumers at the time of sale or issuance of a health insurance policy as to the medical loss ratio of the insurer, health care center, hospital or medical service corporation or other organization.
