AN ACT CONCERNING FINANCIAL AND MANAGEMENT AUDITS OF CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 2-90 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Auditors of Public Accounts to perform financial and management
- 3 audits of municipalities receiving state funding in excess of thirty-five
- 4 per cent of the operating budget of such municipality, and that each
- 5 audit include recommendations for programmatic and management
- 6 efficiencies and financial improvements.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the state auditors to audit the financial records and practices of any municipality that receives state funding equal to more than thirty-five per cent of its operating budget.
