**AN ACT CONCERNING REFUNDS FOR TAXES ERRONEOUSLY
COLLECTED FROM VETERANS AND RELATIVES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-128 of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that the amount of any tax which has been collected erroneously from
- 3 any person who has served in the Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Coast
- 4 Guard or Air Force of the United States, or from his relative, as
- 5 specified in section 12-81 of the general statutes, may be recovered
- 6 from the municipality to which said tax has been paid at any time
- 7 within twenty years from the date of such payment.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow veterans and their relatives to recover any tax collected erroneously by a municipality at any time within twenty years of payment.
