**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A STREAMLINED APPLICATION FOR STATE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Commissioner
- 2 of Social Services, in collaboration with the Commissioners of Children
- 3 and Families, Mental Health and Addiction Services, Public Health,
- 4 and Developmental Services, to develop a streamlined, single
- 5 application that allows state residents to more easily apply for the
- 6 array of state services provided by these agencies.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To simplify and standardize the application process utilized by residents to obtain state offered health and human services.
