AN ACT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A STREAMLINED APPLICATION FOR STATE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Not later than January 1,
2 2010, the Commissioner of Social Services, in collaboration with the
3 Commissioners of Children and Families, Mental Health and
4 Addiction Services, Public Health and Developmental Services, shall
5 develop, and implement the use of, a single, simplified application for
6 state residents to use in applying for programs and services
7 administered by the Department of Children and Families, the
8 Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, the Department
9 of Public Health or the Department of Developmental Services.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
