**AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF AFFORDABLE HEALTH
INSURANCE PLANS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the joint standing
- 2 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
- 3 relating to insurance and real estate to conduct a study of (1) the
- 4 development of health insurance policies that do not contain all the
- 5 health insurance mandates required by title 38a of the general statutes,
- 6 and (2) the impact of such plans on a requirement that all residents in
- 7 this state have health insurance coverage.

Statement of Purpose:

To require a study of affordable health insurance plans that do not contain all the health insurance mandates required by title 38a of the general statutes.
