AN ACT DIRECTING A PORTION OF THE MARIJUANA AND CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES TAX TO MUNICIPALITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 228d of the general statutes be amended to require that
- 2 forty per cent of any revenue collected pursuant to the marijuana and
- 3 controlled substances tax be remitted to the town that referred the
- 4 matter to the Department of Revenue Services, or where any related
- 5 arrest was made.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide towns with an incentive to report matters to the Department of Revenue Services for collection pursuant to the marijuana and controlled substances tax, and to provide additional revenue to towns.
