**AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROCESS OF ACCEPTANCE OF
CLAIMS FOR THE VETERANS' PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-93 of the general statutes be amended to authorize
- 2 towns to accept a claim for property tax exemption by reason of service
- 3 in the armed forces where the claimant: (1) Is more than seventy years
- 4 old, and (2) signs a statement under oath that the claimant was
- 5 honorably discharged from the armed services and that the claimant's
- 6 discharge papers were destroyed by fire or other natural disaster.

Statement of Purpose:

To authorize towns to accept claims for the veterans' property tax exemption where the veteran's discharge papers were destroyed by fire or another natural disaster.
