AN ACT CONCERNING A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF LIGHT RAIL SERVICE IN CONNECTICUT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of
2 Transportation, in consultation with the Transportation Strategy
3 Board, shall analyze regions of the state to determine which regions
4 would be well served by light rail service. Not later than July 1, 2010,
5 said commissioner shall submit a report on the commissioner's
6 findings and recommendations to the joint standing committee of the
7 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to
8 transportation, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of
9 the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	New section

To conduct a feasibility study concerning the use of light rail service in certain regions of the state.
