**AN ACT CONCERNING PESTICIDE APPLICATION AT PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-231b of the general statutes be amended to permit
- 2 all public or private schools to apply pesticide pursuant to an
- 3 integrated pest management plan, to repeal the sunset provision for
- 4 such application, and to impose a civil penalty of one hundred dollars
- 5 per day for a violation of said section.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To permit all public or private schools to apply pesticide pursuant to an integrated pest management plan, to repeal the sunset provision for such application, and to impose a civil penalty of one hundred dollars per day for a violation of said section.
