**AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE BOARD OF ACCOUNTANCY AND CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 20-281d of the general statutes be amended to allow the
- 2 State Board of Accountancy to waive the fee imposed for failure to
- 3 earn the required continuing education requirements by the thirtieth
- 4 day of June, if the applicant is less than two credits short and he or she
- 5 thereafter fulfills the remaining continuing education requirements.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To allow the State Board of Accountancy to waive the fee for failure to fulfill continuing education requirements.
