**AN ACT CONCERNING THE REVOCATION OF A LIQUOR PERMIT  
FOR SELLING ALCOHOL TO AN INTOXICATED PERSON.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 545 of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 the Department of Consumer Protection shall revoke the permit to sell
- 3 alcoholic liquor of a person who, by such person or such person's
- 4 agent, sells any alcoholic liquor to an intoxicated person who, in
- 5 consequence of such intoxication, thereafter causes the death of
- 6 another person.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To hold liquor permittees responsible when their establishment sells alcoholic liquor to an intoxicated person who thereafter causes the death of another person.
