**AN ACT CONCERNING A PHARMACY ERROR DATABASE AND
PHARMACY COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of
- 2 Consumer Protection to establish and maintain a computer database
- 3 concerning pharmacist and pharmacy-related errors or alleged errors
- 4 concerning the dispensing of medication, and that the minutes of
- 5 pharmacy commission meetings be required to contain relevant
- 6 licensee names, as well as license numbers.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect the general public by requiring better tracking of pharmacy-related errors in the dispensing of medication.
