***AN ACT CONCERNING NOTICE OF ABANDONED PROPERTY.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 3-65a of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 holders of abandoned property to provide to the owner of such
- 3 property not less than two notices of the impending transfer of such
- 4 property to the state. Additionally, if the owner of such property does
- 5 not contact the holder of such property within thirty days of the first of
- 6 such notices, the holder of such property shall make reasonable efforts
- 7 to determine the address of the owner prior to sending out the second
- 8 such notice.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To require banks and other holders of abandoned property to make greater efforts to locate and notify owners of such property before such property transfers to the state.
