AN ACT ESTABLISHING FIBROMYALGIA AWARENESS DAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 10-29a of the general statutes is amended by
2 adding subdivision (53) as follows (*Effective from passage*):

3 (NEW) (53) The Governor shall proclaim May twelfth of each year
4 to be Fibromyalgia Awareness Day to heighten public awareness of the
5 associated presentation and available treatments for fibromyalgia
6 disorder. Suitable exercises shall be held in the State Capitol and
7 elsewhere as the Governor designates for the observance of the day.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To enhance awareness of Fibromyalgia.
