AN ACT CONCERNING RESIDENCY RESTRICTIONS FOR REGISTERED SEXUAL OFFENDERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 969 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit a
- 2 person required to register as a sexual offender from residing within
- 3 two thousand feet of the real property comprising a public or private
- 4 elementary or secondary school or a facility providing child day care
- 5 services, as defined in section 19a-77 of the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect children by prohibiting convicted sexual offenders from residing in close proximity to a school or child day care center.
