**AN ACT CONCERNING THE BOUNDARY LINE OF THE TOWN OF
WATERTOWN AND THE CITY OF WATERBURY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the boundary line between the town of Watertown and the city
- 2 of Waterbury be revised by moving the boundary line (1) on Chase
- 3 River Road to the center of the Naugatuck River, and (2) on Route 73
- 4 so that all of the property known as the Pin Shop will be located in the
- 5 town of Watertown.

Statement of Purpose:

To revise the boundary line between Watertown and Waterbury so
that properties impacted will be under the taxing authority of either
Watertown or Waterbury rather than both.
