AN ACT CONCERNING DISCLOSURE OF MAJOR KNOWN FOOD ALLERGENS BY RESTAURANTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 19a of the general statutes be amended to require a
- 2 restaurant to disclose whether the restaurant uses products containing
- 3 the eight major food allergens in the restaurant's kitchen and whether
- 4 any item on the menu contains such products.

Statement of Purpose:

To require restaurants to disclose the use of certain food allergens.
