AN ACT REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO NOTIFY LOCAL LEGISLATIVE BODIES OF URANIUM LEVELS IN THE PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY THAT EXCEED FEDERAL STANDARDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 368a of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Commissioner of Public Health, upon discovering that uranium levels
- 3 in a public water supply exceed standards prescribed by the federal
- 4 Environmental Protection Agency, shall provide written notice of such
- 5 discovery to the legislative body of any municipality impacted by such
- 6 discovery.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Commissioner of Public Health to notify local communities upon discovering that uranium levels in a public water supply used by the community exceed standards prescribed by the federal Environmental Protection Agency.
