AN ACT CONCERNING IDENTIFICATION OF KNOWN FOOD ALLERGENS ON RESTAURANT MENUS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require a restaurant to
- 2 identify those items on the menu that have been prepared with an
- 3 ingredient that is a known food allergen, as determined by the United
- 4 States Food and Drug Administration.

Statement of Purpose:

To safeguard lives by requiring restaurants to identify menu items that have been prepared with any ingredient that is a known food allergen.
