AN ACT CREATING A NEW MOTOR VEHICLE MOVING VIOLATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2009*) (a) When a motor vehicle
2 is stopped at a traffic signal and is struck from behind by a motor
3 vehicle that stopped and then continued, the operator of the motor
4 vehicle that struck the stationary vehicle commits the offense of
5 causing a rear-end collision.
- 6 (b) Causing a rear-end collision is an infraction.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>October 1, 2009</i>	New section
