**AN ACT CONCERNING THE FRANKLIN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL
CONSTRUCTION PROJECT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That, notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision (4) of
2 subsection (b) of section 10-286 of the general statutes or any
3 regulations adopted by the State Board of Education concerning school
4 district enrollment and state standard space specifications, the town of
5 Franklin may use two hundred twenty-five as its enrollment in grades
6 kindergarten to grade eight, inclusive, in connection with its school
7 building project for the Franklin Elementary School, Project No. 053-
8 0011 A/EC/RR, to qualify for the exception to the state standard space
9 specifications requirement in the calculation of school construction
10 project grants.

Statement of Purpose:

To except the town of Franklin from the minimum enrollment requirement for the purposes of state standard space specifications in the calculation of school construction project grants.
