AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEFINITION OF BULLYING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-222d of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 that before a student can be classified as a "bully" or have a letter
- 3 included in such student's file indicating that such student is guilty of
- 4 bullying, the local and regional boards of education hold a hearing that
- 5 includes the parents of the accused.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide a hearing for students and their parents before such students are classified as bullies.
