**AN ACT REQUIRING TRAINING FOR STATE JUDGES REGARDING
THE CRIMINAL USE OF COMPUTERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2009*) Not later than January 1,
2 2010, and annually thereafter, each judge of the Superior Court,
3 Appellate Court or Supreme Court shall attend a course on computer
4 crime developed by the Judicial Branch in accordance with this section.
5 The Judicial Branch shall develop such course on computer crime,
6 which shall include information about the use of computers with
7 respect to child pornography and other crimes. The Judicial Branch
8 shall develop and offer such course with assistance from the
9 Connecticut Judges' Institute and shall update the course annually to
10 reflect new crimes and technological advances.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
