AN ACT CONCERNING RELOCATION COSTS AND ELECTRIC UTILITY RATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2009*) The relocating expenses of
2 any electric distribution company shall not be deemed to be an
3 operating expense in any rate schedule proceedings held pursuant to
4 section 16-19 of the general statutes. For the purposes of this section,
5 "relocating expenses" means any costs associated with the physical
6 transfer of the operations of an electric distribution company in its
7 entirety or of any division of an electric distribution company to
8 another location.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	<i>July 1, 2009</i>	New section
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Statement of Purpose:

To prevent the Department of Public Utility Control from including the cost of relocation when setting an electric utility rate.
